

Würzburg University – Postdoc Positions

Theoretical Particle Physics and Astrophysics

The Institute for Theoretical Physics and Astrophysics at the University of Würzburg invites applications for two postdoctoral positions within the DFG Research Training Group 1147 'Theoretical Astrophysics and Particle Physics'. We are seeking candidates who either have a strong particle physics background or a strong astrophysics background within the following research areas: particle-astrophysics, particle-cosmology and particle physics. Collaboration with the PhD students is expected. One of the positions can be filled starting with 1 April 2010 and the second starting with 1 October 2010.

Currently about 25 PhD students are working within the GRK, in addition 20 faculty members and postdocs are involved. In addition there are collaborations with the particle theory network funded by the German Federal Ministry of Education and Research (BMBF), the Strategic Helmholtz Alliance Physics at the Terascale, MAGIC, LISA and EUSO.
